



## State of Virginia increasing registration fees

Registration fees for passenger vehicles and pick-up trucks will increase \$10.00 statewide, beginning with July 1, 2007 registrations. The increases are part of a wide-ranging transportation funding law passed by this year's General Assembly.

For most Virginians, the standard passenger vehicle registration will increase from \$29.50 annually to \$39.50 annually. Passenger vehicles weighing more than four thousand pounds will see a registration increase from \$34.50 to \$44.50.
