- Never leave your credit/service cards unattended at work.
- Don't leave your credit cards in your vehicle.
- Always check your card when it's returned to you after a purchase. Make sure it is your card.
- **Report lost or stolen cards immediately.** Most fraudulent use of cards takes place within days of being stolen or lost.
- **Destroy cancelled cards** and return them to PHH to ensure you are protected from future fraudulent use.
- **Always check your monthly statement against your actual purchase receipts each month.**
