



UAW Strike update - additional General Motors plants idled

The United Auto Workers (UAW) strike that began last week at American Axle, a parts supplier to General Motors, has now led to the closure of a total of six GM assembly plants.

A current update:

- Note: This could also affect some vehicles ordered for Canada that are built at any of GM's truck assembly plants in the U.S., Canada or Mexico.
