



Update on American Axle/UAW strike and new strike activity

Although negotiations are continuing between American Axle and the UAW, a settlement has not yet been reached. However, strike recovery plans are in place for when GM assembly plants resume production. Fleet orders will be prioritized at the highest level.

In an issue unrelated to the American Axle/UAW strike, the GM assembly facility at Lansing Delta Township went on a local work stoppage Thursday, April 17, 2008. The GMC Acadia, Saturn Outlook and Buick Enclave are produced at that facility. GM is working with the local union in an effort to resolve issues and resume production.
